As part of LaserBond's supply policies, we are committed to corporate responsibility and respecting human rights by ensuring our use of tungsten in our services and products do not directly or indirectly benefit armed groups within the covered countries.

LaserBond expects our suppliers to have in place policies and due diligence measures to provide reasonable assurance that materials containing tungsten are conflict free. We may reconsider continuing partnering with suppliers who are unable to provide this reasonable assurance.

LaserBond will also assist any of our customers with providing reasonable assurance to meet their own conflict minerals compliance programs.
